**Classical Connections** provide the opportunity for teachers to use important classical pieces to further explore musical concepts. Pieces are woven throughout the curriculum appearing at the beginning of each module in grades K-5. This gives teachers the opportunity to expose students to classical pieces repeatedly throughout their elementary music career. Each instance of a piece includes a unique activity suggestion such as movement, listening, playing instruments, and connections to other subjects like Art, History, and Language Arts.
