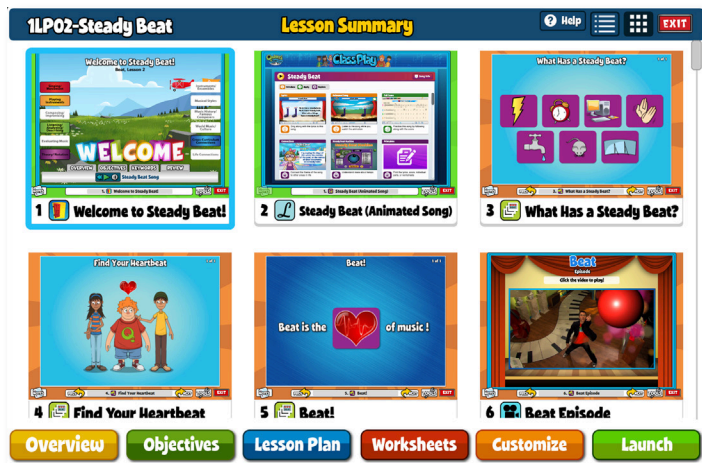
## Here are two easy ways to get started from your Teacher Dashboard:

### 1 • Explore a Complete Lesson

Click the **QUAVER CURRICULUM** icon to open a menu of QuaverMusic lessons organized by grade level. Click any grade level for a sub-collection of lessons, then click the lesson to launch a lesson summary screen.
