Getting Started with QuaverMusic

Once logged in, you'll be taken to your **Teacher Dashboard** – your one-stop-shop for all of your QuaverMusic Resources! The Dashboard can be broken down into three categories: Lessons, Tools, and Teaching Resources.

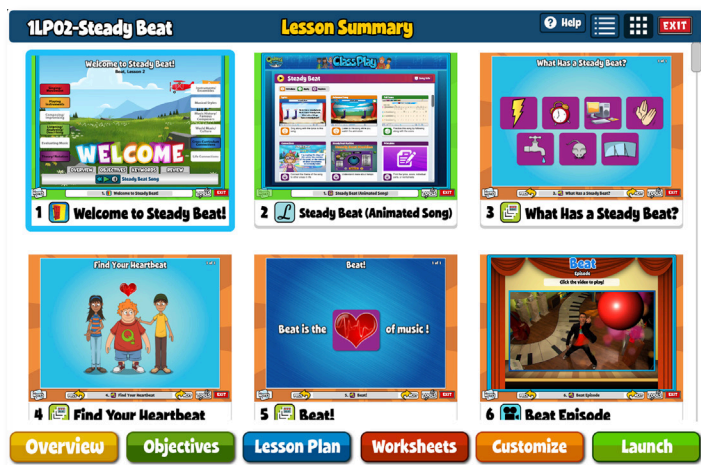
Here are two easy ways to get started from your Teacher Dashboard:

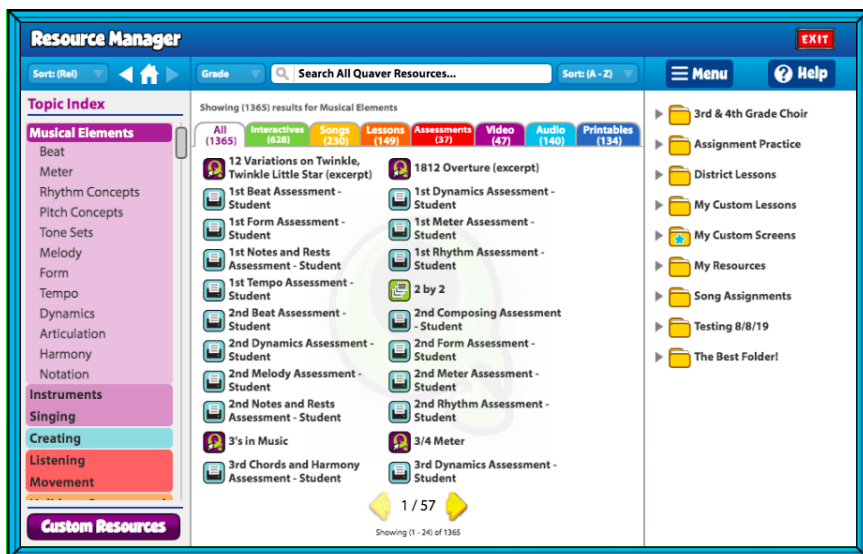
