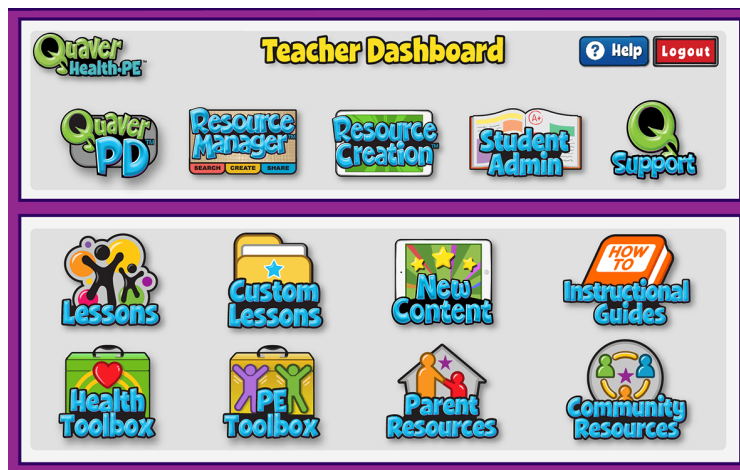
### Getting Started with QuaverHealth•PE!

### Additions in the coming weeks will include:

- **Resource Manager** allows teachers to search for resources within the curriculum as well as customize and share lessons with other teachers in the district!
- **Resource Creation** allows teachers to create their own multimedia screens, import YouTube videos, web links, and upload images and videos of themselves teaching and doing demonstrations. Teachers can also create their own rubrics for performance evaluations and quizzes.
