Scope and Sequence • 6th-8th Grade

Introduction

This scope and sequence document outlines the music theory concepts that are met as teachers use Quaver's 6-8 curriculum. Our middle school curriculum is divided into 14 projects. These projects provide a number of exciting music-making opportunities for middle school students.

Projects

Our projects are cross-curricular and enhance other subject areas that students will be studying in middle school. For example, our Music and Media project looks at contemporary news and media; our Asian Percussion project looks at the history of drumming in Japan, the Middle East, and India; and our Ukulele project looks at the history and performance practice of the ukulele.

The projects require students to collaborate in groups to achieve an active music-making goal. Projects can easily be adapted to meet the needs of the school and classroom. Before the projects are chosen and started, we recommend that the teacher references the associated Quaver Project Book to understand the goals and scope of each project.

Theory

We made the decision to apply the theoretical learning from earlier grades into creative and cross-curricular projects. We do not add more complex theory, such as modulation, circle of fifths, and key signatures, but apply the concepts learned in the Quaver K-5 curriculum. This allows students to solidify their learning and focus on the creative and collaborative opportunities that music-making affords.

Our 6-8 curriculum begins with the Quaver Fundamentals project. Since students may have arrived from different elementary music backgrounds, this project gives teachers the ability to assess their musical knowledge. The teacher can then decide on the projects they would like to select for their students.

Document Framework

The tables included outline musical and cross-curricular concepts taught in the 6-8 curriculum. The table splits the concepts by grade level. Since many students will come to middle school with different backgrounds, the table will help you decide which project will work best for your students by seeing all concepts that are present and the project related to that topic.
